Lesson notes not caught up with, after absence.	Major	Student will receive a letter home. Student will need to attend a detention n which they catch up all notes from class regardless of whether notes are produced subsequently.
Homework not present.	Major	Student will receive a letter home. Student will need to attend a detention regardless of whether homework is produced subsequently.
Unsatisfactory homework.	Major	Student will receive a letter home. Student will need to attend a detention and rewrite the piece of work.
Causing major or repeated disturbance to a lesson.	Major	Student will receive a letter home. Student will need to attend a detention and rewrite the piece of work.

A record will be kept of all minor offences and if a student incurs three within a term a letter will be sent home to parents and Head of Year informed.

If three major offences occur within a term the student's suitability for the course will be called into question and their place on it will be reviewed. This will be referred to parents and both Head of Sixth Form and the Headmaster.
